## "The Meal Fights Hunger" Event Update



The Carnegie-Collier Rotary "The Meal Fights Hunger" program in partnership with the Carnegie Area Ministerial Association held their second "The Meal That Fights Hunger" meal packing event on Saturday, August 29<sup>th</sup> at the Hillside Presbyterian Church on Campbell's Run Road just outside of Carnegie.



Cindi Hewitt reported that we had 128 volunteers to man the two shifts and that they packed 54,216 meals in the 4 hours of work. These meals were donated to the Greater Pittsburgh Food Bank. Between the two events, we have packed and donated 150,000 of these rice based fortified meal pouches. We will be partnering with Andrew Clark of the Adventist Community Services for future events with the hope of packing 1 million meals in 2010 (not all by ourselves!!!). Great Job to all who volunteered and watch for announcements for the next meal packing adventure!!!
